

## **Information on Remote Education - Springwell School**

In some instances it may be necessary to provide remote education to one of, some, or all pupils at Springwell School (see below for further details). In this scenario parents and carers will be contacted, and consulted on, a suitable remote learning plan for their child. This will take into account the age, stage and ability of the child, and provide appropriate educational activities for them to undertake at home.

At Springwell School we strive for high attendance, and want every pupil in school as much as is possible. Remote Education, therefore, is a last resort, and will only take place under the following scenarios:

- Government advice states that the school should be closed to some or all pupils.
- Part or all of the school is dangerous or unusable for a time due to an unforeseen event (i.e. a fire or a flood).
- A child has medical advice not to attend school (i.e. as they are recovering from an operation) AND they feel well enough to learn.

If Remote Education does have to take place it will be for the shortest possible time, with every effort made to facilitate on-site attendance as soon as is possible.

In the event your child is on free school meals Springwell will continue to provide a lunch-time meal in whichever way is most appropriate to the situation necessitating the remote education. This may be i.e. in the form of vouchers, or collection of food from the school etc.
